ORDINANCE 1066

An Ordinance of the City of Bay Minette, Alabama,
Rescinding Ordinance 852, Ordinance 985, Ordinance 1047 and Ordinance 1063 and
Establishing the Election and Appointment of City Officers

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAY MINETTE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I: Pursuant to the authority granted to the City Council by the laws of the State of Alabama, and pursuant to and in furtherance of the procedures heretofore followed by the City Council of said City, and said Mayor and Council shall establish all officers of the City, shall elect and appoint the persons to fulfill those offices, shall fix their terms of service not to exceed the term of the Mayor, shall prescribe the power to be exercised and the duties to be performed by said officers and shall provide for their compensation. The Mayor and City Council may appoint a person to more than one office. Said officers shall include the following:



Treasurer	Court Clerk and Magistrate
Human Resources Director	City Attorney

Fire Chief	Associate Municipal Judge
Building Inspector/Official	City Prosecuting Attorney
Building Maintenance Superintendent	Associate Prosecuting Attorney
Director of Library Services	Public Defense Attorney

ARTICLE II: Except as amended hereby, all previous ordinances (Ordinance 852, Ordinance 985 and Ordinance 1047, Ordinance 1063) of the City pertaining to the election and appointment of officers thereof, shall be rescinded.

ARTICLE III: In the event that any term, provision, covenant or condition of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, invalid, void, or unenforceable, then, in that event, the same shall be severed from this Ordinance and the remainder of the provisions shall remain in full force and effect and shall in no way be affected, impaired, or invalidated.

ARTICLE IV: This Ordinance shall be posted and/or published according to law, and the same shall become effective upon said notification.
