Mayor Wills called the meeting to order and gave the invocation. Councilmember Clemmons led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Consent Agenda

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve the consent agenda. Item A: Approve Minutes if January 22, 2019 City Council Meeting and Work Session.
