THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAY MINETTE, ALABAMA AS HELD MARCH 2, 2020

The regular called meeting of the City Council of the City of Bay Minette was held on March 2, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. at the City Hall in Bay Minette, Alabama; this being the proper place, scheduled date and hour for holding such meeting.

On roll call, the following members of Council were found to be present: Mayor Robert A. Wills; Councilmember Anne Corbett; Councilmember Mike Phillips, Councilmember John Biggs; Councilmember William Taylor; and Councilmember Shannon Clemmons. Mayor Wills called the meeting to order and Councilmember Taylor gave the invocation. Councilmember Phillips led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Consent Agenda

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve the consent agenda. Item A: Approve Minutes of February 18, 2020 City Council Meeting and Work Session; Item B: Consideration of Training Request for Rita Diedtrich, City Clerk to attend the AAMCA Clerk's Summer Conference in Point Clear, Alabama from June 30-July 2, 2020 at a cost of \$872.17. Councilmember Taylor moved to approve the consent agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Biggs and unanimously carried.

The Report of Finance Committees and Board/Commissions included the following:

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve the payables in the amount of \$358,550.27. Councilmember Phillips moved to approve the payables. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Clemmons and carried with the ayes being: Mayor Wills, Councilmember Corbett, Councilmember Phillips, Councilmember Taylor and Councilmember Clemmons; and the nays being: Councilmember Biggs.
