THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAY MINETTE, ALABAMA AS HELD JUNE 15, 2020

The regular called meeting of the City Council of the City of Bay Minette was held on June 15, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. at the City Hall in Bay Minette, Alabama; this being the proper place, scheduled date and hour for holding such meeting.

On roll call, the following members of Council were found to be present: Mayor Robert A. Wills; Councilmember Anne Corbett; Councilmember John Biggs; Councilmember Mike Phillips; Councilmember William Taylor and Councilmember Shannon Clemmons. Mayor Wills called the meeting to order and Councilmember Taylor gave the invocation. Councilmember Clemmons led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Wills recognized Elizabeth Byrd with Heritage Junior Women's Club who presented scholarships to Allie Wilson, Eve Powell, Madison Hastings and Mary Stuart Lewis as well as grants the Bay Minette Public Library Summer Reading Program, the Catfish Roundup and the North Baldwin Coalition for Excellence in Education (NBCEE).

Consent Agenda

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve the consent agenda. Item A: Approve Minutes of June 2, 2020 City Council Meeting and Work Session; Item B: Monthly Reports. Councilmember Phillips moved to approve the consent agenda. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Clemmons and unanimously carried.

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve Resolution Number 0620-09 Appointing a Member to the Bay Minette Board of Adjustments. Councilmember Phillips moved to approve the resolution. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Clemmons and unanimously carried.

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve Resolution Number 0620-10 Appropriation to Baldwin County Child Advocacy Center in the amount of \$1,000 with funds being expended from Contingency Funds as follows: Mayor's-\$500; District 1-\$100; District 2-\$100; District 3-\$100; District 4-\$100 and District 5-\$100. Councilmember Taylor moved to approve the resolution as amended. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Corbett and unanimously carried.
