Mayor Wills called the meeting to order.

Councilmember Taylor gave the invocation.

Councilmember Clemmons led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Consideration of Ordinance

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve Ordinance 1050 Electronic Records and Electronic Signature Policy on first reading. Councilmember Clemmons moved to approve Ordinance 1050 on first reading. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Franklin, and the motion unanimously carried.

Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve Resolution 1124-03 to Grant a Special Exception to Ordinance 1030 Participation of Banned Vehicle Type for the Abba Shrine Street Camels to participate in the Veterans' Day Parade on November 11, 2024 and the Christmas Parade on December 7, 2024. Councilmember Franklin moved to approve Resolution 1124-03. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Clemmons, and the motion unanimously carried.

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Mayor Wills asked for a motion to approve Resolution 1124-04 Authorizing the Purchase of Wireless Headsets for the Bay Minette Fire Department from MC1-Mobile Technology through Omnia Partners Public Sector ("Omnia") Contract. Councilmember Sellers moved to approve Resolution 1124-04. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Franklin, and the motion unanimously carried.
