Basketball began this month with everyone attending. Our team was always backed by enthusiastic students.

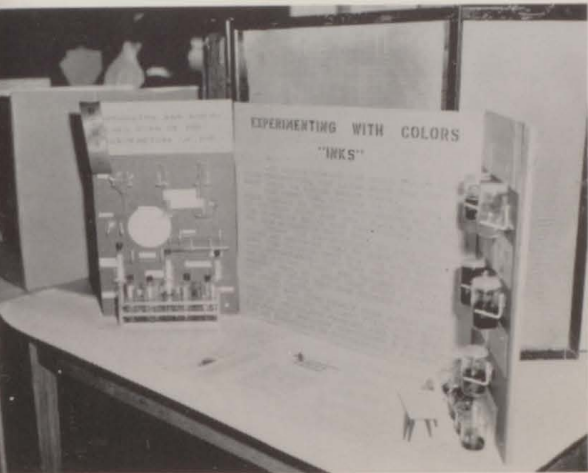




Our Secretarial Club sponsored Backwards Week with a dance the following weekend. The King of Backwards Week, Harold Biggs, was elected.
