Our Prom was held at the City Hall, April 19, the theme being "Oriental Gardens." Everyone really enjoyed the band. They were the Five Keys from Mobile.

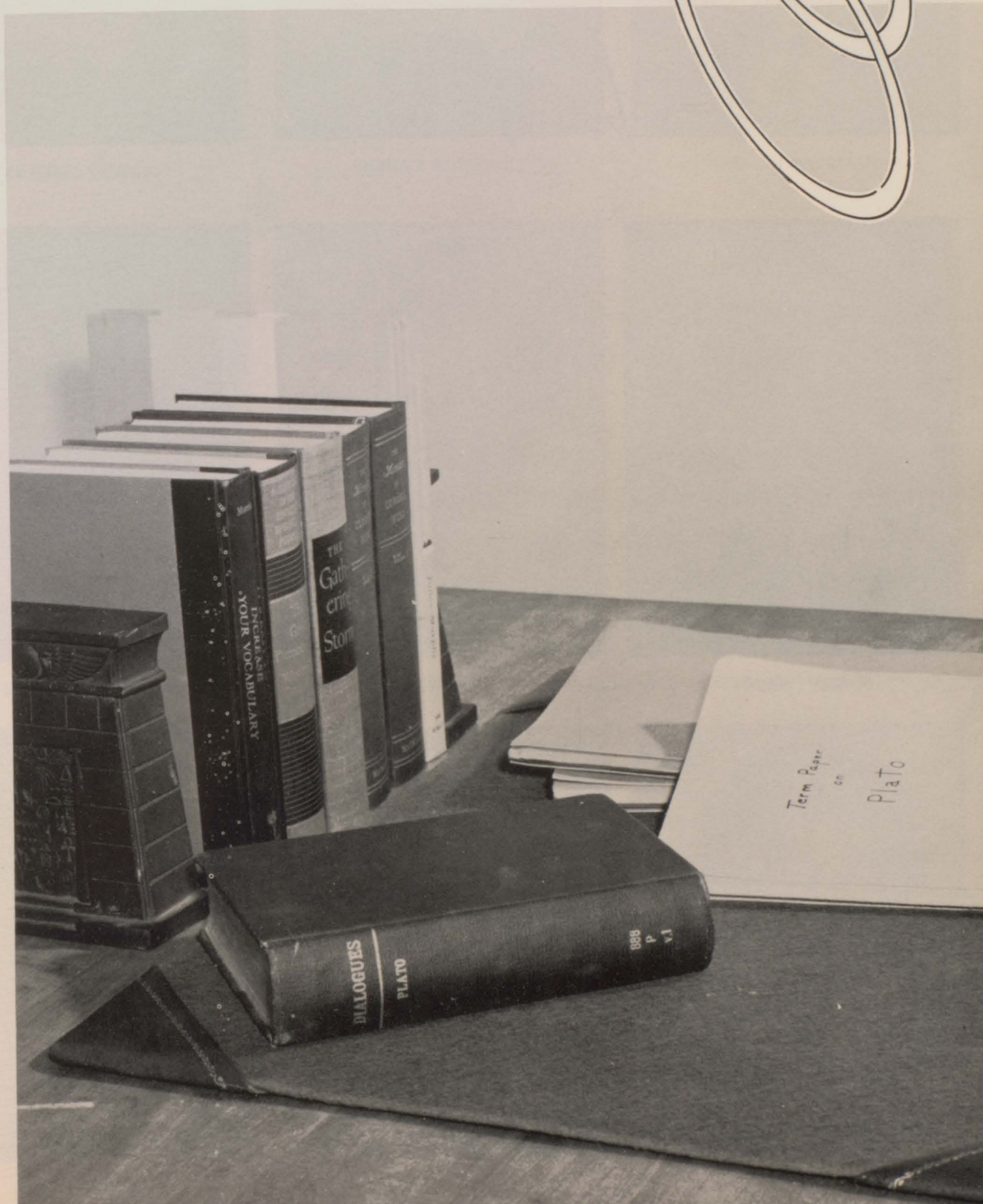
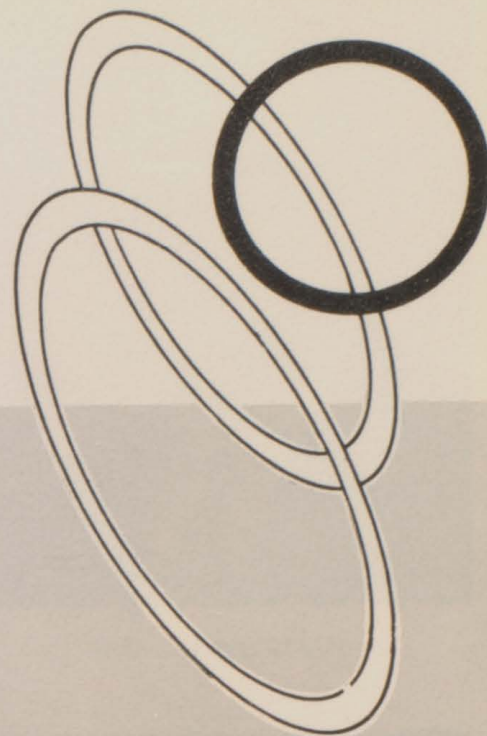
Our freshman year the Frolic was themed "My Valentine," and our Sophomore Hop was given the title "Springtime in the Old South."
