"The Goal Posts are the Gates of Heaven.

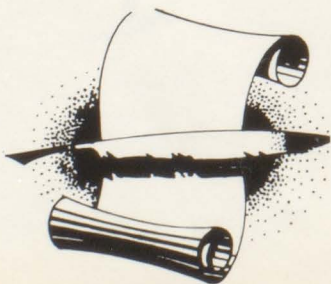
"God is the referee and sole official. He makes all the rules, and there is no appeal from them.

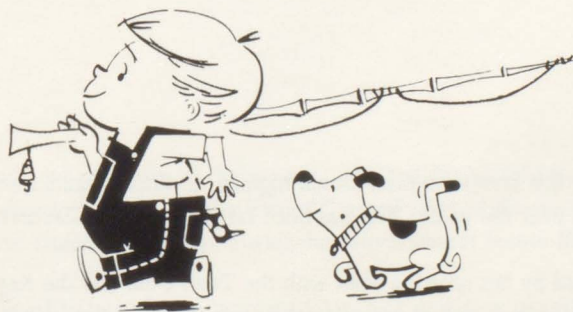

Principal's Message

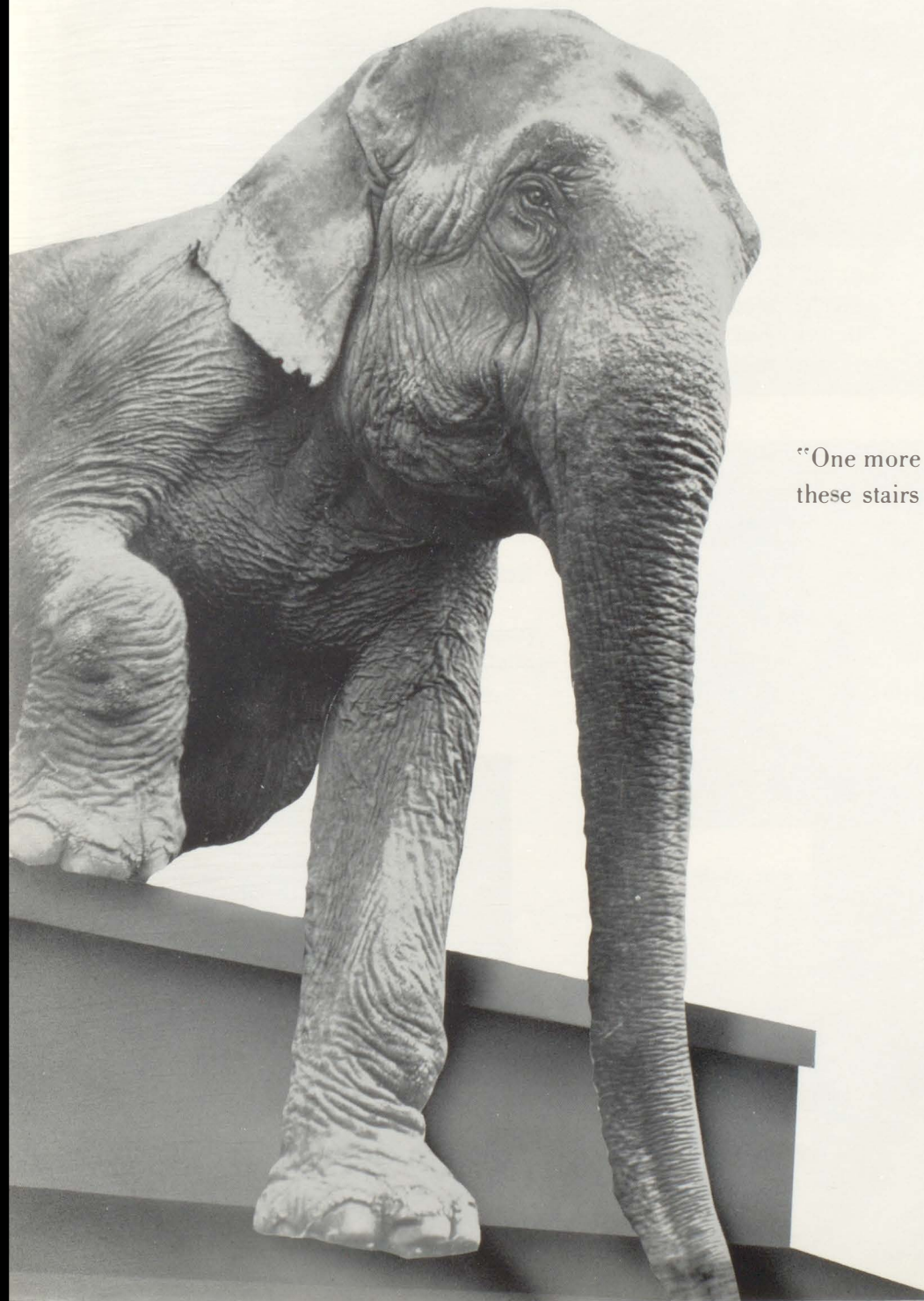


This High School Annual represents our school. From the first page through the last it is a record of the activities, the accomplishments, and the spirit of Baldwin County High School.
