ORDINANCE 1063

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BAY MINETTE, ALABAMA, THE ELECTION AND APPOINTMENT OF CITY OFFICERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAY MINETTE, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I: Pursuant to the authority granted to the City Council by the laws of the State of Alabama, and pursuant to and in furtherance of the procedures heretofore followed by the City Council of said City, and said Mayor and Council shall establish all officers of the City, shall elect and appoint the persons to fulfill those offices, shall fix their terms of service not to exceed the term of the Mayor, shall prescribe the power to be exercised and the duties to be performed by said officers and shall provide for their compensation. The Mayor and City Council may appoint a person to more than one office. Said officers shall include the following:

City Administrator

City Clerk

Community Relations Director

Finance Director

Treasurer

Human Resources Director

City Planner Police Chief

Fire Chief

Building Inspector/Official

Building Maintenance Superintendent

Director of Library Services

Grounds Superintendent

Parks Superintendent

Recreation Director

Superintendent of Streets and Sanitation

Court Clerk and Magistrate

City Attorney

Assistant City Attorney

Municipal Judge

Associate Municipal Judge City Prosecuting Attorney

Associate Prosecuting Attorney

Public Defense Attorney

ARTICLE II: Except as amended hereby, all previous ordinances (Ordinance 852, Ordinance 985 and Ordinance 1047) of the City pertaining to the election and appointment of officers thereof, shall be rescinded.

ARTICLE III: In the event that any term, provision, covenant or condition of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, invalid, void, or unenforceable, then, in that event, the same shall be severed from this Ordinance and the remainder of the provisions shall remain in full force and effect and shall in no way be affected, impaired, or invalidated.

ARTICLE IV: This Ordinance shall be posted and/or published according to law, and the same shall become effective upon said notification.
