

ORDINANCE NO. 1052

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND A PORTION OF ORDINANCE 1039,
SECTION 26, SCHEDULE "P", ENTITLED "LICENSE TAX FOR
COLLECTING, ETC., WAST GREASE AND ANIMAL BY-PRODUCTS".**

WHEREAS, the City of Bay Minette, Alabama ("City") is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Alabama;

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by Alabama law to levy and collect fees for business licenses;

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2023, the City adopted Ordinance No. 1039, providing for the levy and collection of business licenses and fees beginning January 1, 2024;

WHEREAS, the Ordinance contained herein shall operate to amend Ordinance 1039.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Bay Minette, Alabama at a regular meeting, duly assembled, a quorum being present, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment of Ordinance 1039, Section 26, Schedule "P" – License Tax for Collecting, etc., Waste Grease and Animal By-Products. Section 26, Schedule "P" entitled " License Tax for Collecting, etc., Waste Grease and Animal By-Products " is amended such that Schedule "P" shall hereafter read as follows:

Schedule "P" - License Tax for Collecting, etc., Waste Grease and Animal By-Products

Each person engaged in the business of purchasing and receiving waste grease and animal by-products for rendering or recycling, from businesses, schools, and institutions located in the City of Bay Minette, shall pay the following annual business license tax:

POPULATION	TAX
OVER 100,000	\$50.00
25,000 TO 100,000	\$25.00
12,000 TO 25,000	\$20.00
6,000 TO 12,000	\$15.00
2,000 TO 6,000	\$10.00
0 TO 2,000	\$5.00


Notwithstanding any provision contained in Ordinance 1039 to the contrary, the annual license fee for 2024 pursuant to Schedule "P" – License Tax for collection, etc., waste grease and animal by-products shall be due and payable on or before _____.

Section 2. Ordinance Cumulative. All other provisions of Ordinance 1039 shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be affected by this Ordinance.

Section 3. Severability. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then such ruling shall not affect any other paragraph and sections, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.
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Section 4. Effective Date of Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Bay Minette and publication as required by law.
